THE SENATE STANDING ORDERS

REMOVAL FROM OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR OF EMBU COUNTY

IT IS notified for the information of the general public:

THAT pursuant to Article 181 of the Constitution and section 33 of the County Governments Act, 2012, on 29th April, 2014, the

County Assembly of Embu approved a Motion "to remove from office, by impeachment," the County Governor of Embu County:

AND THAT by a letter dated 29th April, 2014 (Ref: CAE/SCA/1/35) received in the Office of the Speaker of the Senate on 30th April, 2014, the Speaker of the County Assembly of Embu informed the Speaker of the Senate of the approval of the Motion by the County Assembly and further forwarded to the Speaker of the Senate documents in evidence of the proceedings of the Assembly:

AND FURTHER THAT pursuant to section 33 (3) (b) of the County Governments Act, 2012 and standing order 68 (1) (b) of the Senate Standing Orders, the Senate, by Resolution on Tuesday, 6th

May, 2014 appointed a special committee comprising eleven of its members to investigate the matter of the proposed removal from office of the Governor of Embu County and to report to the Senate within ten days of its appointment on whether it finds the particulars of the allegations to have been substantiated:

AND THAT pursuant to section 33 (4) of the County Governments Act, 2012 and standing order 68 (2) of the Senate Standing Orders, the special committee investigated the matter and tabled its Report in the Senate on Tuesday, 13th May, 2014:

AND THAT pursuant to sections 33 (4) and 33 (6) (b) of the County Governments Act, 2012 and standing order 68 (4) (b) of the Senate Standing Orders, the special committee found that the particulars of the following allegations against the Governor of Embu County had been substantiated; namely—

- (a) gross violation of the Public Procurement and Disposal Act, 2005;
- (b) gross violation of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012; and
- (c) gross violation of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010;

Pursuant to section 33 (6) (b) of the County Governments Act, 2012, and standing order 68 (4) (b) of the Senate Standing Orders, the Senate, after according Martin Nyaga Wambora, the Governor of Embu County, an opportunity to be heard, did on Tuesday, 13th May, 2014 resolve to impeach Martin Nyaga Wambora, the Governor of Embu County, on the following grounds; namely—

- (a) gross violation of the Public Procurement and Disposal Act, 2005;
- (b) gross violation of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012; and

(c) gross violation of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010.
