- (h) Pursuant to the provisions of regulation 57 (1) and (2) of the Elections (General) Regulations, 2012 every political party and every independent candidate at the by-election shall submit to

the Commission names of the Chief Agent on or before 20th April, 2015.

- (i) The campaign period shall Commence on 6th April, 2014 and cease on 1st May, 2015 being 48 hours before the by-election day which is 4th May, 2015.
- (j) The campaign time shall run from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. during the campaign period.
- (k) If the by-election is contested, the poll will take place on the 4th May, 2015.
