The Terms of Reference of the Taskforce are to-

- (a) co-ordinate and provide strategic leadership in implementation of the Programme:
- (b) analyze and give up-to-date status of maize grain and such other essential commodities (maize, sugar and powdered milk) as the case may be in the Country to determine supply and demand;
- (c) ensure implementation of the Programme is in line with Government policy objectives;
- (d) identify possible sources of the duty exempted essential commodities and their competitive import prices;
- (e) monitoring maize and maize products and other essential commodity prices in the market as the case may be and advise accordingly;
- (f) monitor and evaluate the progress and implementation of the Programme;
- (g) prepare progress reports on implementation of the Programme; and
- (h) perform any other function necessary to ensure effective coordination and implementation of the Programme realization of its objectives.

Reporting

In the performance of its functions, the Taskforce shall be responsible to the Cabinet Secretary for Agriculture, Livestock and Fisheries.

Meeting

In the discharge of its mandate, the Taskforce shall hold such number of meetings in such places and at such times as the Taskforce may consider necessary for the proper discharge of its functions and shall regulate its own procedures.

Secretariat and Inter-Ministerial Technical Committee

The Taskforce shall have a Co-ordination Secretariat based at the Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock and Fisheries, State Department of Agriculture and an Inter-Ministerial Technical Committee for the effective performance of its functions.

Terms of Office

The Taskforce shall remain in office for a period of four (4) months from 2nd May, 2017 or for such a longer period as the Cabinet Secretary may by notice in the Gazette prescribe.

Co-option

The Taskforce may co-opt any other member(s) whose skills and experience are necessary for the performance of its functions.

Biodiversity loss

- Only clear vegetation absolutely necessary for the construction activities.
- Avoid the use of Invasive Alien Species in the landscaping activities.
- Determine Access roads which are to be used by machinery used in the construction and site clearance phase development to avoid the unnecessary trampling of vegetation that will be maintained within the development area.
- Ensure that green belts' which have been proposed for the STW are large as possible as small patches may not be able to support viable populations of some species and these small patches tend to more susceptible to edge effect.

It possible position these green belts in adjacent to existing vegetated areas. In addition species richness tends to increase with area, which would be the desired outcome of the incorporation of green belts.

Disturbance of traffic flow

- Provide diversion routes where possible.

- Traffic department should approve crossing plan prior to construction, and should approve obstruction times during construction.

- A guard should be available 24 hours to help people access across pipeline trenches.
- Alternatives access ways should be communicated to the community.

Solid waste

- Use an integrated wastes management system observing the following hierarchy of options: Reduction at source Recycling Reuse Combustion Land filling.
- Incorporation of waste management commitments contained in the Waste Management Guidelines.
- Agreement with suppliers to accept the return of unused materials.
- Agreement with and license details of companies to be used for the off-site transport of wastes.
- Workforce training programs in waste minimization practices.
- Where practical any excess materials will be returned to the supplier.
- Waste oil will be collected for transport and off-site disposal littering, specifically of the natural areas, should be prevented. Adequate containers for litter removal should be supplied on site. These containers should be emptied on a regular basis and the contents removed to an appropriate and licensed waste disposal site.
- The Contractor shall set up a solid waste control and removal system.
- · Bins shall be emptied on a daily basis.
- Waste and litter shall be disposed of into scavenger – and weather proof bins. The contractor shall then remove the refuse collected from the working areas, from site at least once a week.
- Adherence to Waste Management Regulations of 2006.

Air pollution

 Drivers should be instructed on the benefits of driving practices that reduce both the risk of accidents and fuel consumption, including measured acceleration and driving within safe speed limits.

- Contractors should consider additional ways to reduce potential impacts including implementing a regular vehicle maintenance and repair program.
- Recruit staff from the surrounding communities to decrease the travelling distance thus reducing emissions from vehicular traffic.
- Ensure that all vehicles involved in the transport of construction material and staff, and machinery involved in the construction is properly maintained and serviced.
- Machines must not be left idling for unnecessary periods of time; this will save fuel and reduce emissions.
- Use of dust control methods, such as covers water suppression.
- Ensure that all trucks carrying aggregate and sand are covered during delivery to the site.
- Ensure that all material (sand and aggregate) stockpiled on the site to be used in construction activities are regularly sprayed to reduce the effects of wind whipping.
- Care must be taken in the unloading construction materials (aggregate, sand and cement) to prevent spillage. If a spill occurs, this should be cleaned up as soon as possible.
- Extra care must be taken to reduce dust in periods when wind speed is greatest and the rainfall amounts are lowest. This will involve extra wetting of the construction area to suppress dust particles.
- Retain a buffer area of trees and other vegetation generally around the perimeter of the development site which will serve as a natural windbreaks which may reduce the level of dispersion of dust particles generated during this phases of the development.
- All raw materials must be sourced as close as possible to the construction site thus reducing the emissions from vehicular traffic.
- All waste must be transported off- site for processing, not burnt or stored for any longer than is absolutely necessary.
- Adherence to Air Quality Regulations, 2014
- Only remove vegetation from areas for the STW/sewers construction.
- Install appropriate drainage systems to direct water away from slopes.
- Avoid as far as possible the traversing of bare soil by vehicles to reduce soil compaction.
- Designate a main access route for heavy machinery.
- Avoid site preparation in period when wind velocities are highest.
- Areas storing hazardous substances such as diesel must be properly contained in a bunded area (With capacity to contain I ½ times the amount of substances stored. This area must be situated away from project activities and signs indicating the storage of these

- substances erected. Care must be taken when handling these hazardous substances to avoid spills.
- In the event of an oil spill the contaminated soil must be removed and disposed off.

Noise and vibration

- Best available work practices will be employed on-site to minimize occupational noise levels.
- All construction equipment will be regularly inspected and maintained in good working condition.
- Combine noisy operations so that they occur at the same time. The total noise level will not be significantly louder than the level produced if the operations were to be undertaken separately.

- Temporary barriers such as earth berms, zinc fencing and sound dampening fencing such as acoustic screens should be employed to reduce the impact of noise to the existing residents.
- Ensure that construction activities for the development of the project are staggered to decrease the levels of noise and vibration in the area.
- Construction hours should be limited to the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m.

Damage of underground • infrastructure

- Get maps of the underground infrastructure from the relevant institutions.
- Sensitize workers carrying out Excavations so that they exercise caution to minimize chances of underground infrastructure damage.
- Work closely with the responsible institutions so that incase of damage, the services are restored within the shortest time.
- Notify affected parties if service needs to be temporarily relocated or was affected by the project works.

Structural stability

The geotechnical report should include suitable measures for confining vibrations within project sites. These measures should be tailored according to the proximity of buildings to the project sites and earthwork program.
