PURSUANT to Article 176 (1) of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 as read together with section 12 (1) and 12 (3) (d) of the County Governments Act, 2012 and section 8 and 9 of the County Assembly Services Act, 2017, the County Assembly of Mandera invites application from suitably qualified interested candidates, (one male and one female), to serve as members of the County Assembly Service Board.

Requirements for Appointment:

- (a) Must be a citizen of Kenya;
- (b) Hold a degree from a University recognized in Kenya;
- (c) Has at least ten (10) years experience in public affairs; and
- (d) Meet the requirement of leadership and integrity in Chapter Six of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010.

Application Criteria

Persons interested in filling the above positions should submit applications accompanied by certified copies of the following documents—

- (a) Detailed *curriculum vitae* (CV);
- (b) Certified Academic and professional certificates;
- (c) KRA Clearance certificate;
- (d) Compliance certificate from Higher Education Loans Board (HELB);
- (e) Certificate of Good conduct from the Department of Criminal Investigation (DCI);
- (f) Certified copy of the National Identity Cards or passport.

Note:

Candidates with foreign degrees must obtain recognition from the Commission for Higher Education and equation qualification from the Kenya National Qualifications Authority. All applications should be hand delivered to the Office of the Clerk, County Assembly of Mandera Offices, Mandera County, on or before the 16th November, 2022 at 5.00 p.m.
