# POLICE NOTICE Porlwi By Light

By virtue of authority conferred upon me by Section 25(3) of the Police Act and Section 181 (1) (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Act, unless otherwise directed by Police, traffic arrangements as hereunder will be made in Port-Louis on Thursday 01.12.2016, Friday 02.12.2016, Saturday 03.12.2016 and Sunday 04.12.2016 from 18.00 hours to 01.00 hours in connection with above event.

#### 2. Traffic Diversion Scheme

- (a) Motorway will remain open to traffic and vehicles will move freely towards the North and South;
- (b) Vehicles coming from the South along New Trunk Road proceeding towards Plaine Verte will use either auto-pont or Caudan Round About to emerge onto Brabant Street-Lord Kitchener Street Jemmapes Street Volcy Pougnet Street Labourdonnais Street turn right onto Pope Henessy Street then left onto D'Estaing Street, Eugene Laurent Street towards SSR Street;
- (c) Vehicles coming from direction of Grand Rivière along A1 & Proceeding towards Plaine Verte when reaching junction of Jemmapes & Lord Kitchener Streets will be diverted towards Jemmapes Street Volcy Pougnet Street- Labourdonnais Street turn right onto Pope Henessy Street then left onto D'Estaing Street, Eugene Laurent Street towards SSR Street;
- (d) Vehicles coming from the North along the motorway & proceeding towards Champs De Mars & City Centre will after Quay D Round about use Farquhar Street Joseph Rivière Street Cross Royal Street & Sir Seewoosagur Ramgoolam Street Sir Virgil Naz Street- Mgr Gonin Street to proceed towards Champs De Mars;

- (e) Vehicles coming from Plaine Verte & Sainte Croix and proceeding towards Champs De Mars & Labourdonnais Street will proceed towards Boulevard Pitot; or through Sir Seewoosagur Ramgoolam Street Mgr Gonin Street; and
- (f) Buses for routes 51 & 52 will be diverted along Motor Way through Guy Rozemont Square.

#### 3. Closure of Road

Entrance of Quay Street, Port Louis up to Rotary Island near Aapravasi Ghat opposite Louis Pasteur Street, Port Louis.

#### 4. Pedestrian Zone

- (a) John Kennedy Street from its junction Edith Cavell to Queen Street;
- (b) Reverend Le Brun from John Kennedy to Mallefille Streets;
- (c) Chaussée Street from Reverend. Le Brun to that of Queen Elizabeth II Street;
- (d) Dr. Ferrière Street;
- (e) Poudrière Street from Chausée to Lislet Geoffroy, Maillard Streets;
- (f) Intendance Street;
- (g) Queen Street from Corner Duke of Edinburg to Louis Pasteur Streets;
- (h) Farquhar Street from Duke of Edinburg Street to Louis Pasteur Street;
- (i) Bourbon Street from Queen Street to Sir Seewoosagur Ramgoolam Street;
- (i) P. Hennessy Street from c/r J. Koenig G. Guibert Streets to c/r Labourdonnais Street;
- (k) Sir William Newton from Mauritius Post and Commercial Bank to Sir Seewoosagur Ramgoolam Street;
- (1) Bissoondoyal Square; and
- (m) Sir Seewoosagur Ramgoolam Street from Corner Bourbon Street to Jules Koenig Street.

#### 5. Vehicles will be parked at the following places:

- (a) Les Salines Neo Town; and
- (b) Champs de Mars

#### 6. Motorway M3 – Terre Rouge – Verdun

Vehicles from the North towards the South and vice-versa, may also use motorway M3- Terre Rouge – Verdun Link Road as same will be operational up to 00.00 hrs from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> December, 2016.

# 7. Judicial proceedings

Non compliance with these traffic arrangements will entail judicial proceedings.

The cooperation and understanding of the public would be much appreciated.
