Directions to voters

1. Each elector **MUST** produce her/his National Identity Card or passport or the identification badge from the Nursing Council of Mauritius when s/he applies for a ballot paper, failing which s/he will **NOT** be authorized to vote.

2. Each elector will be issued with a ballot paper comprising **seven (7)** sections namely:-
 - Section A: Candidates from the **General Nursing** category
 - Section B: Candidates from the **Psychiatric Nursing** category
 - Section C: Candidates from the **Nursing or Midwifery Education** category
 - Section D: Candidates from the **Community Health Nursing** category
 - Section E: Candidates from the **Midwifery** category
 - Section F: Candidates from the **Nursing Administration (Nursing Supervisors & above)** category
 - Section G: Candidates from the **Nursing Officers from Private Sector** category
3. Each elector **shall** vote in **all** the **seven** sections and for **twelve (12)** candidates, namely:
 - (i) **five (5)** candidates from the category of **General Nursing** (Section A);
 - (ii) **one (1)** candidate from the category of **Psychiatric Nursing** (Section B);
 - (iii) **one (1)** candidate from the category of **Nursing or Midwifery Education** (Section C);
 - (iv) **one (1)** candidate from the category of **Community Health Nursing** (section D);
 - (v) **one (1)** candidate from the category of **Midwifery** (section E);
 - (vi) **one (1)** candidate from the category of **Nursing Administration (Nursing Supervisors & above)** (section F); and
 - (vii) **two (2)** candidates from the category of **Nursing Officers from Private Sector** (section G)

by putting a cross (x) opposite the name of each candidate of her/his choice.
4. If an elector votes for **MORE** candidates or a **LESSER** number of candidates than the number required in each section or does not vote in any of the seven sections or places any mark or writing on the ballot paper by which s/he could afterwards be identified, her/his vote(s) will be void and will not be counted.
5. If an elector inadvertently spoils a ballot paper, s/he may return it to the Presiding Officer, who, on being satisfied of the fact, will give her/him a fresh ballot paper.
6. Registered nurses or midwives will normally vote at the polling stations earmarked for their respective sites of work as listed above. However, those who will be on leave on poll day may exceptionally vote at any other polling station, after the necessary verifications have been carried out.
7. All retired nurses or midwives will vote at the polling station nearest to their residence.
8. No elector will be allowed to vote by proxy, **except** those serving in Agalega or at Mauritian Embassies or High Commissions abroad.
9. An elector who has appointed a proxy to vote on her/his behalf will not be entitled to vote in person.
