POLICE NOTICE

YAMSEE FESTIVAL 2018 ON 17, 18, 19 & 20 SEPTEMBER 2018

By virtue of authority conferred upon me by Section 25(3) of the Police Act and 181 of the Road Traffic Act, traffic arrangements as hereunder will be made on 17, 18, 19 & 20 September, 2018 on the occasion of the Yamsee Festival in Plaine Verte division.

2. CLOSED STREETS

(a) ON 17, 18 & 19 SEPTEMBER, 2018

The following Streets will be closed to vehicular traffic as from 18.00 hrs until the ceremony is over:-

- (i) Paul et Virginie Street from its junction with Trichinapoly Street up to Dr. Hassen Sakir Street;
- (ii) Dr. Hassen Sakir Street from its junction with Paul et Virgine up to Pamplemousses Streets;
- (iii) Pamplemousses Street from its junction with Imam Bacosse Suddar Street up to Khadafi Square;
- (iv) Madad Ul Islam (Ex. Magon) Street from its junction with St Francois Xavier up to Paul et Virgine Street;
- (v) Sir Edgar Laurent Street from Khadafi square up to Doire Street;
- (vi) Nyon Street from its junction with La Paix Street up to Sir Edgar Laurent Street;
- (vii) Aile Dore Street from its junction with Sir Edgar Laurent up to Canal Bathurst Street;
- (viii) Oblique Street from its junction with Military Road up to Large Street;
- (xi) Military Road from its junction with St Francois Xavier up to Pamplemousses Streets;
- (x) Madras Street from its junction with Pamplemousses up to St Francois Xavier Streets; and
- (xi) All side roads connection the Pamplemousses Street with Paul et Virgine – Trichinapoly and Aile Dore Streets, Plaine Verte.

(b) On 20 SEPTEMBER, 2018 AS FROM 15.00 HRS UNTIL THE CEREMONY IS OVER

- (i) Dr. Hassen Sakir Street, Plaine Verte;
- (ii) Pamplemousses Street, Plaine Verte from Khadafi Square up to Sophia Lane, Cité La Cure – Ducray Street, Ste Croix and lateral roads;
- (iii) Madras Street from its junction with Pamplemousses up to François Xavier Streets;

- (iv) Military Road from its junction with St François Xavier up to Pamplémousses Streets; and
- (v) Oblique Street from Military Road up to Large Street.

3. DIVERSION OF TRAFFIC ON 20 SEPTEMBER, 2018 AS FROM 15.00 HRS UNTIL THE PROCESSION IS OVER

- (a) Vehicular traffic coming from the North along Pamplémousses Street proceeding towards the South and Immigration Bus Stand will be diverted at Abercrombie roundabout onto Nicolay Road Ste Croix via Noor E Islam Street – Military Road and Sir Edgar Laurent Streets;
- (b) Vehicular traffic coming from Nicolay Roads, Cocoterie Roads, Ste Croix and proceeding towards Cite La Cure will pass by Abercrombie Round About – Pamplémousses Road, Ste Croix – Allee Pere Laval – Ste Croix Street into Ste Marie Street to Cite La Cure;
- (c) Vehicular traffic coming from Military Road near BAT and proceeding towards Vallee des Pretes will be diverted at Corner Military and Ambrosine Streets into Nicolay Road via Abercrombie Round About – Pamplémousses Road – Allee Pere Laval – Ste Croix Street into Ste Marie Street to Vallee des Pretes;
- (d) Vehicular traffic coming from Bernandin de St Pierre and Vallee des Pretes proceeding to the South will be diverted at Sophia Lane, Vallee des Pretes into Ste Marie Street – Le Cornu Street – Pieton Pere Laval Street – Allee Pere Laval – Pamplémousses Road, Ste Croix via Nicolay Road, Ste Croix.
- (e) Vehicular traffic coming from the South along St François Xavier Street and proceeding towards the North will do so via Ambrosine Street into Nicolay Road near BAT.

4. BUS STOPS

All bus stops along Pamplémousses Street will not be operational on 20 September, 2018 for the embarkation and disembarkation of passengers.

5. JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS

Non compliance with these traffic arrangements will entail judicial proceedings.

The cooperation and understanding of the public would be much appreciated.
