THE MEDICAL COUNCIL ACT 1999

NOTICE OF ELECTION OF FOURTEEN (14) MEMBERS OF THE MEDICAL COUNCIL OF MAURITIUS

Notice is hereby given to all fully registered redical practitioners that the election of fourteen 4) members of the Medical Council of fauritius[comprising eight (8) members from the ublic sector, of whom four (4) shall be specialists nd four (4) shall be general practitioners; and ix(6) members from the private sector, of whom ree (3) shall be specialists and three (3) shall e general practitioners] will be conducted by 1e Office of the Electoral Commissioner on aturday the twenty sixth (26th) day of January 019; and that the Returning Officer will receive ie nomination papers for the said election on aturday the fifth (5th) day of January, 2019, etween the hours of 10 am and 2 pm at the seat f the Medical Council of Mauritius. One Way loreal Road, Cité Mangalkhan, Floreal.

Nomination papers may be obtained either from ne Registrar at the seat of the Medical Council of fauritius at the abovementioned address or from ne Health Director, Queen Elizabeth Hospital, 'rève Coeur, Rodrigues, between the hours of 9 am nd 3 pm, on working days(excluding Saturdays). Every nomination paper must be signed by five fully registered medical practitioners and be delivered to the Returning Officer between the said hours of 10 am and 2 pm on 5 January, 2019.

Every nomination paper shall specify the name, address and date of registration of the candidate and also contain a declaration by the candidate that:-

- (a) on nomination day he/she is a fully registered medical practitioner and is not otherwise suspended;
- (b) on nomination day he/she reckons at least 15 years' experience as a medical practitioner in Mauritius; and
- (c) he /she is a citizen of Mauritius.

No person shall be qualified to be nominated as a candidate where he/she is under investigation for misconduct by the Council, or has been subject to disciplinary sanction by the Council during the 5 years preceding the nomination.

Nomination papers received by post, fax, email or otherwise will not be considered.
