- Each elector will be issued with a ballot paper comprising of two sections namely:-
SECTION A: Candidates from the Public Sector; and
SECTION B: Candidates from the Private Sector.
- Each elector shall vote for eight (8) candidates, namely:
 - three (3) candidates in SECTION A (Public Sector); and
 - five (5) candidates in SECTION B (Private Sector)
 by putting a cross (X) opposite the name of each candidate of his/her choice.
- If an elector votes for **more** than **three (3)** or **less** than **three (3)** candidates in SECTION A **and** for **more** than **five (5)** or **less** than **five (5)** candidates in SECTION B or places any mark or writing on
