- 2. Each elector will be issued with a ballot paper comprising of two sections namely:-

SECTION A: Candidates from the Public Sector; and

SECTION B: Candidates from the Private Sector.

- 3. Each elector shall vote for eight (8) candidates, namely:
 - (i) three (3) candidates in SECTION A (Public Sector); and
 - (ii) five (5) candidates in SECTION B (Private Sector)

by putting a cross (X) opposite the name of each candidate of his/her choice.

 If an elector votes for <u>more</u> than three (3) or <u>less</u> than three (3) candidates in SECTION A and for <u>more</u> than five (5) or less than five (5) candidates in SECTION B or places any mark or writing on
