Notice is hereby given under Section 20 of the Environment Protection Act 2002 by the Department of Environment, Ministry of Social Security, National Solidarity, and Environment and Sustainable Development (Environment and Sustainable Development Division) that an application for an EIA Licence has been submitted on 2 July 2019 under Section 18(1) of the Act for a scheduled undertaking and that the EIA report shall be opened for public inspection.

- (a) The undertaking concerns the Proposed 5-Star hotel and World Class Conference and Seminar Centre on a plot of State Land of an extent of about 43 arpents by Atalian Global Services Ltd
- (b) The location of the proposed undertaking is at Les Salines Koenig, Rivière Noire in the district of Black River

POLICE NOTICE

TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENT IN CUREPIPE DIVISION INDIAN OCEAN ISLAND GAMES FOOTBALL MATCHES AT NEW GEORGE V STADIUM

In virtue of Section 25(3) of the Police Act and Section 181 of the Road Traffic Act, traffic arrangements as hereunder will be made in Curepipe Division for football matches at New George V Stadium in the context of the Indian Ocean Island Games (IOIG) 2019

2. Date and time the Traffic Schemes will be Operational

- (a) Thursday 18.07.19 as from 1330 to 1800 hrs;
- (b) Saturday 20.07.19 as from 1030 to 1800 hrs;
- (c) Monday 22.07.19 as from 1030 to 1800 hrs;
- (d) Wednesday 24.07.19 s from 1300 to 1800 hrs;
- (e) Friday 26.07.19 as from 1300 to 1800 hrs; and
- (f) Saturday 27.07.19 as from 1300 to 1800 hrs.

3. Closure of Roads

- (a) Louis Pasteur Street will be closed to vehicular traffic as from Swastika Mandir to its Junction with Boulevard Victoria;
- (b) Barry Street will be closed to vehicular traffic as from its junction with Royal Road to its Junction with Boulevard Victoria except for residents and
- (c) Boulevard Victoria (northbound) will be closed to vehicular traffic from its Junction

with Celicourt Antelme street to that with Barry Street.

4. Two Way Street

- (a) Celicourt Antelme Street will be converted into a two way street as from its Junction with Royal Road to that with Boulevard Victoria Street;
- (b) De Caen Street (southbound) will be converted into a two way street from its Junction with Barry Street to that with Celicourt Antelme Street and
- (c) Louis Pasteur Street will be converted into a two way street from its Junction with Royal Road up to Swastika Mandir (residents only).

5. Diversion of Traffic

- (a) Vehicles coming from La Vigie Round About and proceeding towards Curepipe Town Centre will proceed on contraflow along De Caen Street as from its Junction with Celicourt Antelme Street to resume its normal flow at Junction with Barry Street.
- (b) Vehicles coming from La Vigie Round About proceeding towards Curepipe Town Centre and Forest Side will be diverted into Celicourt Antelme Street.

6. No Parking Zone/Sites

The following streets will be declared as a No Parking Zone:

- (a) Celicourt Antelme Street;
- (b) Louis Pasteur Street;
- (c) Barry Street and
- (d) Boulevard Victoria on both northbound and southbound as from Manhattan Round About up to De Rochecouste Street.

7. Parking Zones

The following parking sites will be used:-

- (a) Forum parking lot (except on Wednesdays and Saturdays) and
- (b) Off the road (one side) in the vicinity of Forum and NTA;
- (c) SGS Ltd (ex NTA) on Saturdays only.

(d) In the vicinity of Forest Side SSS (Boys);

Drivers are to abide with directives given by Police officers who will be deployed to regulate traffic and help road users.

8. Judicial Proceedings

Non compliance with these traffic arrangements will entail judicial proceedings.

POLICE NOTICE

OPENING CEREMONY - INDIAN OCEAN ISLAND GAMES (IOIG) 2019 AT ANJALAY COOPEN STADIUM

The public is hereby informed that by virtue of authority conferred upon me under Section 25 (3) of the Police Act 1974 and Section 181 of the Road Traffic Act 1962, traffic arrangements, as hereunder, will be made on the occasion of the Opening Ceremony of the Indian Ocean Islands Games 2019 at Anjalay Coopen Stadium at Belle Vue Harel on 19 July 2019.

2. PROHIBITED PARKING

As from 1200 hrs to 2200 hrs no vehicle will be allowed to park or remain stationary along both sides of the undermentioned roads:

- (i) Bois Rouge Road from Pamplemousses Roundabout to Belle Vue Harel Roundabout;
- (ii) Middle Road, Mapou from Mapou Roundabout to Belle Vue Harel Roundabout;
- (iii) Middle Road, Plaine des Papayes from Belle Vue Harel Roundabout to entrance of Centre Thermique Belle Vue; and

(iv) Middle Road from Mapou Roundabout to Rivière Du Rempart District Council.

3. ROAD CLOSURE AS FROM 1430 HRS TO 2200 HRS

Bois Rouge Road, as from Pamplemousses Roundabout on M2 to Belle Vue Harel Roundabout, will be closed to vehicular traffic, except for Emerald Card Holders, Residents of Bois Rouge, IOIG officials, coaches conveying athletes and normal route buses.

4. TRAFFIC DIVERSION SCHEME

Normal vehicular traffic will be diverted as follows:

- (i) Vehicular traffic coming from the direction of Plaine des Papayes and proceeding towards Pamplemousses, will on reaching Belle Vue Harel Roundabout use Middle Road towards Mapou Roundabout and Motorway M2.
- (ii) Vehicular traffic coming from Pamplemousses and proceeding towards Plaine des Papayes will on reaching Pamplemousses Roundabout proceed along Motorway M2 towards Mapou Roundabout, Middle Road and Belle Vue Harel Roundabout

5. ROUTE TO ANJALAY COOPEN STADIUM FOR EMERALD CARD HOLDERS, IOIG OFFICIALS AND COACHES CONVEYING ATHLETES

- (a) Emerald card holders and IOIG officials proceeding to Anjalay Coopen Stadium from the direction of Plaine des Papayes will use Middle Road Plaine des Papayes Belle Vue Harel Roundabout Bois Rouge Road to Anjalay Coopen Stadium and will park on Anjalay Coopen Stadium parking area inside the main entrance.
- (b) Emerald card holders and IOIG officials proceeding to Anjalay Coopen Stadium from the direction of Grand Bay, Piton will use Motorway M2 Mapou Roundabout-Pamplemousses Roundabout Bois Rouge Road towards Anjalay Coopen Stadium

- and will park on Anjalay Coopen Stadium parking area inside the main entrance.
- (c) Emerald card holders, IOIG officials & athletes coaches proceeding to Anjalay Coopen Stadium from the direction of Pamplemousses Roundabout will use Bois Rouge Road up to Anjalay Coopen Stadium. Cars will be parked on Anjalay Coopen Stadium parking area inside the main entrance. Coaches after alighting athletes in front of the main entrance will then proceed to the sugar track (ex Route 22) for parking.

6. ROUTE TO ANJALAY COOPEN STADIUM FOR YELLOW CARD HOLDERS

Yellow card holders proceeding to Anjalay Coopen Stadium from the direction of:

- (i) Grand Bay and Piton will use Motorway
 M2 Mapou Roundabout Middle Rd
 and park on Anjalay Coopen Stadium
 Public Parking;
- (ii) Plaines des Papayes will use Middle Road
 Belle Vue Harel Roundabout Middle
 Rd and park on Anjalay Coopen Stadium
 Public Parking;
- (iii) Pamplemousses and the south will use Motorway M2 Pamplemousses Roundabout Mapou Roundabout Middle Road and park on Anjalay Coopen Stadium Public Parking.

7. ROUTE TO ANJALAY COOPEN STADIUM FOR THE GENERAL PUBLIC

Vehicles of the general public proceeding to Anjalay Coopen Stadium from the direction of:

- (i) Grand Bay and Piton will use Motorway M2 Mapou Roundabout Middle Road;
- (ii) Plaines des Papayes will use Middle Road – Belle Vue Harel Roundabout – Middle Road;
- (iii) Pamplemousses and the south will use Motorway M2 Pamplemousses Roundabout Mapou Roundabout Middle Road

and park on the football ground found behind Anjalay Coopen Stadium.

Drivers are to abide with directives given by Police officers who will be deployed to regulate traffic and help road users.

8. JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS

Non compliance with these traffic arrangements will entail judicial proceedings.
