PROCEDURE FOR ADVERTISING IN THE GOVERNMENT GAZETTE OF THE REPUBLIC OF NAMIBIA

- The Government Gazette Extraordinary containing advertisements, is published on every Friday. If a Friday falls on a Public Holiday, the Government Gazette is published on the preceding Thursday.
- Advertisements for publication in the Government Gazette must be addressed to the Government Gazette Office, P.B. 13200, Windhoek, 9000, or be delivered at Room 27, Cohen Building, Windhoek, not later than 15h00 on the ninth working day before the date of publication of the Government Gazette in which the advertisement is to be inserted.
- Advertisements are published in the Government Gazette for the benefit of the public. Translations, if desired, must be furnished by the advertiser or his agent.
- 4. Only legal advertisements shall be accepted for publication in the Government Gazette and are subject to the approval of the Secretary, Civic Affairs and Manpower who may refuse the acceptance or further publication of any advertisement.
- The Secretary, Civic Affairs and Manpower reserves the right to edit and revise copy and to delete therefrom any superfluous detail.
- 6. Advertisements must as far as possible be typewritten. The manuscript of advertisements must be written on one side of the paper only and all proper nouns plainly inscribed. In the event of any name being incorrectly printed as a result of indistinct writing, the advertisement can only be reprinted on payment of the cost of another insertion.

- 7. No liability is accepted for any delay in the publication of advertisements/notices, or for the publication of such on any date other than that stipulated by the advertiser. Similarly no liability is accepted in respect of any editing, revision, omission, typographical errors or errors resulting from faint or indistinct copy.
