PROMULGATION OF ACT OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

The following Act which has been passed by the National Assembly and signed by the President in terms of the Namibian Constitution is hereby published in terms of Article 56 of that Constitution.

APPROPRIATION ACT, 1990

ACT

To appropriate amounts of money to meet the financial requirements of the State during the financial year ending 31 March 1991.

(Signed by the President on 31 July 1990)

BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Republic of Namibia, as follows:-

Appropriation of amounts of money for financial requirements of State.

1. Subject to the provisions of the State Finance Act, 1982 (Act 1 of 1982), there are hereby appropriated for the financial requirements of the State during the financial year ending 31 March 1991, as a charge to the State Revenue Fund, the amounts of money shown in the Schedule.

Short title.

2. This Act shall be called the Appropriation Act, 1990.
