CHARACTERISTICS OF COMMEMORATIVE COINS TO BE ISSUED BY THE BANK OF NAMIBIA TO CELEBRATE THE FIFTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE INDEPENDENCE OF THE REPUBLIC OF NAMIBIA

In terms of section 22(3) of the Bank of Namibia Act, 1990 (Act 8 of 1990), the Bank of Namibia hereby announces the characteristics of coins to be issued by the Bank and which have been approved by the Minister of Finance under section 22(2) of the Bank of Namibia Act, 1990.

1. Coins will be issued in the following denominations:

100 Namibia Dollars (N\$100)
10 Namibia Dollars (N\$10)
1 Namibia Dollar (N\$1)
2. On the obverse side of the coins the following features appear:
(a) The Namibian National coat-of-arms.
(b) The words "Republic of Namibia".
(c) The year 1995
3. On the reverse side of the coins the following features appear:

Sand-dunes coloured gold and brown with the words "5th Year of Independence".
4. The $\$ 100$ coin is made of gold, the $\$ 10$ coin is made of silver and the $\$ 1$ coin is made form a copper/nickel alloy. The coins all have a diameter of 37 mm and a plain edge.
