## CHARACTERISTICS OF COMMEMORATIVE COINS TO BE ISSUED BY THE BANK OF NAMIBIA TO CELEBRATE THE MISS UNIVERSE NAMIBIA 1995 PAGEANT

In terms of section 22(3) of the Bank of Namibia Act, 1990 (Act 8 of 1990), the Bank of Namibia hereby announces the characteristics of coins to be issued by the Bank and which have been approved by the Minister of Finance under section 22(2) of the Bank of Namibia Act, 1990.

1. Coins will be issued in the following denominations:

1 Namibia Dollar (N\$ 1)
10 Namibia Dollars (N\$ 10)
100 Namibia Dollars (N\$100)
2. On the obverse side of the coins the following features appear:
(a) The Namibian National coat-of-arms over the year 1995 and the words "Republic of Namibia" (in capital letters).
3. On the reverse side of the coins the following features appear:
(a) $\$ 1$ CUPRO-NICKEL COIN

An oryx in natural colours and the words "Miss Universe Namibia".
(b) $\$ 10$ SILVER COIN

The head of a leopard in natural colours and the words "Miss Universe Namibia".
(c) $\$ 100$ GOLD COIN

The head of a lioness in natural colours and the words "Miss Universe Namibia".
4. The $\$ 100$ coin is made of gold, the $\$ 10$ coin is made of silver and the $\$ 1$ coin is made of cupro-nickel alloy. The coins all have a diameter of 37 mm and a plain edge.
