APPLICATION FOR AIR SERVICE LICENCE

The following applications for Scheduled Air Transport Services, Non-scheduled Air Transport Services, Flying Training Air Services or Aerial Work Air Services indicate (1) reference number; (2) name of applicant and nature of application; (3) number and type of aircraft; (4) nature of proposed air service; and (5) routes over or area within which the proposed air services are to be rendered and are published in terms of section 5 of the Air Services Act, 1949 (Act 51 of 1949) as amended. Representations by interested parties in respect of the applications shall comply with the requirements of section 6 of the Air Services Act, 1949 (Act 51 of 1949) and shall be in ninefold in respect of each application and shall be delivered by hand or sent by registered post to the Secretary, Transportation Commission of Namibia, Private Bag X12005, Windhoek to reach that office not later than 21 days after the date of publication of this Government Gazette.

FLY-IN-SAFARIS & FLIPS

- 1. **One hour flip over Swakopmund,** the salt fields, the dunes, Walvis Bay, Rossing Uranium Mine, the moon-landscape or Sandwich Harbour:
 - 5 persons maximum R 100.00 per person.
 - 4 persons R 125.00 per person.
 - 3 persons R 165.00 per person.
- 2. **Two hour flight over Swakopmund,** Walvis Bay, the salt fields, Sandwhich Harbour, the seal colonies, the shipwrecks, the high red sand dunes banking the Kuiseb River, the Kuiseb canyon, Rossing Uranium

Mine and the moon-landscape:

- 5 persons maximum R 200.00 per person.
- 4 persons R 250.00 per person.
- 3 persons R 330.00 per person.
- 3. Three hour flight over Swakopmund, Walvis Bay, Sandwich Harbour, the diamond area, the seal colonies, the shipwrecks, Hollandbirds-island, Sossusvlei (the highest shifting dunes of the world the Kuiseb canyon, Rössng Uranium Mine and the moon-landscape:
 - 5 persons maximum R3 00.00 per person.
 - 4 persons R 375.00 per person.
 - 3 persons R 495.00 per person.
- 4. **Three hour flight to Sossusvlei**, including an overnight stop on a guest-farm, same route as 3 with stay-over and 4 x 4 ride to Sossusvlei all inclusive:
 - 5 persons maximum R 750.00 per person.
 - 4 persons R 950.00 per person.
 - 3 persons R 1 320.00 per person.
- 5. **Etosha pan -** Flight to the largest and most famous game reserve in Namibia, including two night stopover at the luxurious Makuti Lodge or at one of the rest camps. Bed, breakfast and game viewing are included:
 - 5 persons maximum R1 500.00 per person.
 - 4 persons R1 800.00 per person.
 - 3 persons R2 380.00 per person.

Each additional day would be an extra R 400.00 per person.

Single night stopovers also possible on request.

- 6. **Hobatere Lodge** (situated on the western Otjovasandu entrance to the Etosha Pan). Flying time over Damaraland, southern parts of Kaokoland and Skeleton Coast approximately 4,5 hours. Accommodation for one night, breakfast, dinner and 3 hours game viewing are included:
 - 5 persons maximum R 800.00 per person.
 - 4 persons R 1 000.00 per person.
 - 3 persons R 1 300.00 per person.

Day-tour (4 x 4) to the Ovahimbas or into the western part of the Etosha pan on request at extra cost.

- 7. **Palmwag Lodge -** (Damaraland, Skeleton Coast). Flying time approximately four hours return via the Brandberg mountain. Lunch at Palmwag Lodge and two hours game viewing in 4 x 4. Return flight over the Uniab River, Skeleton Coast, and seal colony to Swakopmund.
 - 5 persons maximum R 800.00 per person.
 - 4 persons R 1 000.00 per person.
 - 3 persons R 1 300.00 per person.

Overnight stop at Palmwag on request at extra cost.

- 8. Luderitz (Luderitzbucht) (including return flight approximately six hours). Fly over hundreds of kilometers of deserted diamond fields along the Atlantic coast, rich in bird life. Shipwrecks, guano islands, crowded seal islands and over the highest shifting dunes at Sossusvlei. Crayfish meals at Lüderitz can be arranged at extra cost.
 - 5 persons maximum R 600.00 per person.
 - 4 persons R 750.00 per person.
 - 3 persons R 1 000.00 per person.
 - Overnight stop can be arranged at extra cost.
- 9. Flights to any points of interest in Namibia, as well as special requests can be arranged at any time.
