RESERVATION OF LAND FROM PROSPECTING AND MINING
OPERATIONS AND INVITATIONS FOR APPLICATIONS FOR
GRANT OF EXCLUSIVE PROSPECTING LICENCES: MINE-
RALS (PROSPECTING AND MINING) ACT, 1992

1. Under the powers vested in me -
 - (a) by section 122(1) of the Minerals (Prospecting and Mining) Act, 1992 (Act 33 of 1992), I hereby declare that no person other than the holder of a reconnaissance licence shall, notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the said Act or any other law, but subject to any right conferred upon the holder of any mining claim, exclusive prospecting licence, mineral deposit retention licence or mining licence by the said Act by the date of this notice, and which exists on the date immediately before the date of this notice, carry on any prospecting operations or mining operations in, on or under any land or area from latitude 23°33 south to latitude 25°47 south and between the high water mark of the Atlantic Ocean out to the 200 m isobath of that ocean; and
 - (b) by section 122(2) of that Act I hereby call for applications for the grant of exclusive prospecting licences in respect of precious stones over, on or under the area of land described in paragraph (a).

2. Application referred to in paragraph 1(b) must be submitted in accordance with the requirements of the provisions of sections 47 and 68 of the Minerals (Prospecting and Mining) Act, 1992 and be accompanied by the prescribed annual licence fees, which fees shall be refunded in respect of any unsuccessful applications.
3. In addition to the application requirements referred to above, the attention of all applicants are invited to the provisions of section 50 of the Minerals (Prospecting and Mining) Act, 1992 "General terms and conditions of mineral licences". Due consideration of such provisions should be given in the compilation of applications and, in a related manner, applicants' intentions regarding the participation of Namibians in proposed ventures which would be encouraged by the Ministry, should be indicated.
4. Particulars of the area of land referred to in paragraph 1(a) may be obtained from the Commissioner's Office.
5. Applications must be lodged with the Commissioner, Ministry of Mines and Energy, Private Bag 13297, Windhoek, not later than three calendar months from the date of publication of this notice.

AIRCREW EXAMINATIONS: ENTRY REQUIREMENTS, EXAMINATION SCHEDULE AND VENUES

1. This notice contains all the requirements and dates for aircrew examinations for 1997.
2. **COMMERCIAL PILOT'S EXAMINATION (INCLUDING INSTRUMENT FLIGHT RATING)**
 - 2.1 The candidate must be the holder of a valid private pilot licence issued in terms of the Air Navigation Regulations 1976, as amended, or the holder of a licence issued by a foreign licensing authority provided that such licence shall be acceptable to the Director as the equivalent to at least a private pilot licence.
3. **AIRLINE TRANSPORT PILOT EXAMINATION**
 - 3.1 The candidate must be the holder of a valid Commercial Pilot Licence issued in terms of the Air Navigation Regulations 1976, as amended, except in the case where such examinations are sat for a purpose other than acquiring a Namibian pilot licence.
4. **INSTRUMENT FLIGHT RATING**
 - 4.1 The candidate must be the holder of at least a valid private pilot licence.
5. **FLIGHT INSTRUCTOR RATING**
 - 5.1 The candidate must be the holder of at least a valid Commercial Pilot Licence issued in terms of the Air Navigation Regulations 1976, as amended, or have passed the technical examinations for the Commercial Pilot Licence.

6. FLIGHT INSTRUCTOR ENDORSEMENT

6.1 An applicant that applies for the turbopropeller and turbojet endorsement, shall:

- (a) be the holder of a valid flight instructor rating issued in terms of the Air Navigation Regulations 1976, as amended;
- (b) have completed an approved course of training;
- (c) pass a written examination in:
 - (i) theory of high altitude flight; and
 - (ii) the application of aero-medicine to high altitude flying and
- (d) pass a practical flight instructor test conducted by an official examiner or by a person designated in writing by the Director.
