PROMULGATION OF ACT OF PARLIAMENT

The following Act which has been passed by the Parliament and signed by the President in terms of the Namibian Constitution is hereby published in terms of Article 56 of that Constitution.

No. 7 of 1998: Pharmacy Profession Amendment Act, 1998.

ACT

To amend the Pharmacy Profession Act, 1993, so as to make a different provision for the term of office of the members of the Pharmacy Board.

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of the Republic of Namibia, as follows :-

Amendment of section 5 of Act 23 of 1993, as amended by section 1 of Act 22 of 1994

1. Section 5 of the Pharmacy Profession Act, 1993, is amended -
 - (a) by the substitution for subsection (4) of the following subsection:

“(4) Any member of the Board shall, subject to subsection (4A), hold office for a period of three years and shall, at the expiry of such period, be eligible for re-election.”; and

- (b) by the insertion after subsection (4) of the following subsection :

“(4A) Notwithstanding subsection (4) -

- (a) any person elected as a member of the Board prior to the commencement of the Pharmacy Profession Amendment Act, 1998, shall be deemed to have been so elected for a period of office of four years;

- (b) the Minister may by notice in the *Gazette* extend the period of office of the members of the Board referred to in paragraph (a) for a period not exceeding one year.”

Short title

2. This Act shall be called the Pharmacy Profession Amendment Act, 1998.
