# PROMULGATION OF ACT OF PARLIAMENT

The following Act which has been passed by the Parliament and signed by the President in terms of the Namibian Constitution is hereby published in terms of Article 56 of that Constitution.

## **ACT**

To amend the Public Service Act, 1995, so as to designate the Electoral Commission established by the Electoral Act, 1992, as an agency.

(Signed by the President on 30 October 1998)

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of the Republic of Namibia as follows:-

#### Amendment of section 3 of Act No. 13 of 1995

1. The following subsection is inserted after subsection (1) of section 3 of the Public Service Act, 1995:

"(1A) For the purposes of subsection (1), the Electoral Commission established by section 3 of the Electoral Act, 1992 (Act No. 24 of 1992), shall be deemed to be an agency."

# Amendment of Schedule 3 to Act No. 13 of 1995, as amended by section 37 of Act No. 13 of 1997

- 2. Schedule 3 to the Public Service Act, 1995, is amended -
- (a) by the insertion before the expression "Namibia Central Intelligence Service" in column 1 of the expression "Electoral Commission"; and
- (b) by the insertion before the expression "Director: Namibia Central Intelligence Service" in column 2 of the expression "Director of Elections".

3. This Act shall be called the Public Service Amendment Act, 1998, and shall come into operation on a date to be determined by the Minister of Justice by notice in the *Gazette*.
