In terms of section 13 of the Townships and Division of Land Ordinance, 1963 (Ordinance No. 11 of 1963), I declare the area situated on Portion 74, a portion of Portion B, of Farm Swakopmund Town and Townlands No. 41 in the Municipal Area of Swakopmund, Registration Division "G" and represented by General Plan No. G120 (S.G. A836/2003) to be an approved township.

The conditions, subject to which the application for permission to establish the township concerned has been granted, are set out in the Schedule in terms of the said section 13.

### SCHEDULE

## 1. Name of township

The name of the township shall be called Swakopmund Waterfront.

## 2. Composition of township

The township comprises of 65 erven numbered 1 to 65 and streets as indicated on General Plan No. G120 (S.G. A836/2003).

## 3. Reservation of erven

Erven 1, 13 and 52 are reserved for the Local Authority of Swakopmund for purposes of public open spaces.

## 4. Conditions of title

The following conditions shall be registered in favour of the Local Authority against the title deeds of all erven, except erven 1, 13 and 52 referred to in paragraph 3:

- "(a) The erf shall only be used for purposes, which are in accordance with, and the use or occupation of the erf shall at all times be subject to the provisions of the Swakopmund Town Planning Scheme, prepared and approved in terms of the Town Planning Ordinance, 1954 (Ordinance No. 18 of 1954), as amended.
- (b) The building value of the main building to be erected on the erf, excluding the outbuildings, shall be at least four times the valuation of the erf by the local authority.".
