DECLARATION OF NKURENKURU TO BE AN APPROVED TOWNSHIP:
KAVANGO REGIONAL COUNCIL

In terms of Section 13 of the Townships and Division of Land Ordinance, 1963 (Ordinance No. 11 of 1963), I declare the area situated on Portion 1 of the Farm Nkurenkuru Townlands No. 1346 in the Registration Division "B" as indicated on General Plan No. B 171 (Diagram S. G. No. A 139/2001) to be an approved township.

The conditions, subject to which the application for permission to establish the township concerned has been granted, are set out in terms of the said Section 13 in the Schedule below.

Name of Township

1. The Township shall be called **Nkurenkuru**.

Composition of Township

2. The Township comprises of 386 erven numbered 1 to 52, 54 to 155, 157 to 388, 6 public open spaces numbered 53, 156, 389 to 392 and streets as indicated on General Plan B 171 (S. G. A 139/2001).

Reservation of erven

3. (1) The following erven are reserved for the State:

Erven 2, 80 to 82 and 86 for general administration purposes.

- (2) The following erven are reserved for the Local Authority:
 - (a) Erven 53, 156, 389, 390, 391 and 392 for public open spaces;
 - (b) erven 7, 87 and 88 for general administration purposes.

- 4. (1) The following conditions shall be registered in favour of the Local Authority against the title deeds of all erven, except the erven referred to in paragraph 3.
 - (a) There shall be no obstruction or deviation of any natural course of storm water over the erf without the written approval of the Local Authority.
 - (b) The erf shall be subject to the reservation for the Local Authority of the right of access and use without compensation of the area three metres parallel with any boundary of such erf, for the construction and maintenance of Local Authority services in respect of water, sewerage, drainage, electricity and gas, which right includes the right to place on such erf temporarily any material that may be excavated during such operation on the erf or any adjacent erf.
 - (c) If the erf has more than one street frontage, access to the erf shall be obtained from the street determined by the Local Authority.
 - (d) No offensive trade shall be established or conducted on the erf.
 - For the purpose of this item, "offensive trade" means any of the businesses, trades, works or institutions mentioned in regulation 1(a) of the Regulations promulgated under Government Notice No. 141 of 10 November 1926.
 - (e) No cattle, pigs, goats, sheep, monkeys, beasts of prey or draught-animals shall be kept or allowed on the erf.
- (2) The following conditions shall, in addition to those enumerated in sub-paragraph (1), be registered in favour of the Local Authority against the title deeds of erven 1, 3 to 6, 8 to 10, 13 to 16, 26 to 32, 34, 36 to 52, 54 to 58, 60, 63 to 74, 96 to 104, 106 to 145, 147 to 155, 158 to 214, 216 to 255, 257 to 272, 274, 276 to 289, 291 to 346, 348 to 388:

- (a) The erf shall be used for residential purposes only.
- (b) The building value of the main building, including the outbuildings to be erected on the erf, shall be at least four times the valuation of the erf by the Local Authority.
- (3) The following conditions shall, in addition to those enumerated in sub-paragraph (1), be registered in favour of the Local Authority against the title deeds of erven 11, 12, 17 to 25, 76, 79, 83 to 85, 89 to 95, 105, 146, 215, 275, 347:
 - (a) The erf shall only be used for flats and business purposes other than a factory, but where a building is erected for business purposes the ground floor of the main building shall not contain flats, and flats shall not be constructed on the same floor as any business or offices.

For the purpose of this paragraph, "factory" means a factory as defined in regulation 14 of the Regulations relating to the Health and Safety of Employees at Work promulgated under Government Notice No. 156 of 1 August 1997.

- (b) The building value of the main building, including the outbuildings to be erected on the erf, shall be at least four times the valuation of the erf by the Local Authority.
- (4) The following conditions shall, in addition to those enumerated in subparagraph (1), be registered in favour of the Local Authority against the title deed of erven 61, 75, 157, 256, 273 and 290:
- (a) The erf shall be used for institutional purposes and purposes incidental thereto only.
 - For purposes of this item, "institutional purposes" means schools, places of institution, churches, community halls, clinics, crèches and similar uses.
- (b) The building value of the main building, including the outbuildings to be erected on the erf, shall be at least two times the valuation of the erf by the Local Authority.
- (5) The following conditions shall, in addition to those enumerated in sub-paragraph (1), be registered in favour of the Local Authority against the title deed of erven 33, 35, 59, 62, 77 and 78:

 - (2) The following erven are reserved for the Local Authority:
 - (a) Erven 3 and 208 for educational purposes;
 - (b) erven 216, 234 and 262 for general administration purposes.

- 4. (1) The following conditions shall be registered in favour of the Local Authority against the title deeds of all erven except the erven referred to in paragraph 3:
 - (a) There shall be no obstruction or deviation of any natural course of storm water over the erf without the written approval of the Local Authority.
 - (b) The erf shall be subject to the reservation for the Local Authority of the right of access and use without compensation of the area 3 meters parallel with any boundary of such erf, for the construction and maintenance of municipal services in respect of water, sewerage, drainage, electricity and gas, which right includes the right to place on such erf temporarily any material that may be excavated during such operation on the erf or any adjacent erf.

- (d) No offensive trade shall be established or conducted on the erf.

- (e) No cattle, pigs, goats, sheep, monkeys, beasts of prey or draught animals shall be kept or allowed on the erf.
- (2) The following conditions shall, in addition to those enumerated in subparagraph (1), be registered in favour of the Local Authority against the title deeds of erven 15 to 53, 55 to 69, 71 to 207, 209 to 213, 215, 219 to 227, 269 to 342 and 347:
 - (a) The erf shall be used for residential purposes only.
 - (b) The building value of the main building, including the outbuildings, to be erected on the erf shall be at least four times the valuation of the erf.
- (3) The following conditions shall, in addition to those enumerated in subparagraph (1), be registered in favour of the Local Authority against the title deeds of erven 1; 2; 4; 5; 8 to 14; 217; 218; 235 to 261 and 263 to 268:
 - (a) The erf shall be used for flats and business purposes other than a factory, but where a building is erected for business purposes the ground floor of the main building shall not contain flats and no flats shall be constructed on the same floor as any business or offices.
 - For the purpose of this item "factory" means a factory as defined in regulation 14 of the Regulations relating to the Health and Safety of Employees at Work promulgated under Government Notice No. 156 of 1 August 1997.
 - (b) The building value of any new main building, including the outbuildings, to be erected on the erf shall be at least four times the valuation of the erf by the Local Authority.
- (4) The following conditions shall, in addition to those enumerated in subparagraph (1), be registered in favour of the Local Authority against the title deeds of erven 6; 7; 70 and 214:
 - (a) The erf shall only be used for institutional purposes and purposes incidental thereto.
 - For the purpose of this item "institutional purposes" means schools, places of instruction, churches, community halls, crèches, clinics and similar uses.
 - (b) The building value of the main building, including the outbuildings to be erected on the erf, shall be at least two times the valuation of the erf by the Local Authority.

2. The Township comprises of 267 erven numbered 1 to 267 and streets as indicated on General Plan B 180 (S. G. A No. 459/2002).

Reservation of erven

- **3.** (1) The following erven are reserved for the State:
 - (a) Erven 68, 69 and 136 for educational purposes;
 - (b) erven 40 and 266 for general administration purposes;
 - (c) erf 187 for a clinic.
 - (2) The following erven are reserved for the Local Authority:
 - (a) Erven 135 and 263 for public open spaces;
 - (b) erven 251, 252 and 258 for general administration purposes.

- 4. (1) The following conditions shall be registered in favour of the Local Authority against the title deeds of all erven except the erven referred to in paragraph three:

- (3) The following conditions shall, in addition to those enumerated in subparagraph (1), be registered in favour of the Local Authority against the title deeds of erven 149 to 155, 158 to 160, 212 to 236:
 - (a) The erf shall only be used for flats and business purposes other than a factory, but where a building is erected for business purposes the ground floor of the main building shall not contain flats, and flats shall not be constructed on the same floor as a business or offices.
 - For purposes of this item, "factory" means factory as defined in regulation 14 of the Regulations relating to the Health and Safety of Employees at Work promulgated under Government Notice No. 156 of 1 August 1997.
 - (b) The building value of the main building, including the outbuildings to be erected on the erf, shall be at least three times the valuation of the erf by the Local Authority.
- (4) The following conditions shall, in addition to those enumerated in subparagraph (1), be registered in favour of the Local Authority against the title deed of erf 249:
 - (a) The erf shall only be used for institutional purposes and purposes incidental thereto.
 - For purposes of this item, "institutional purposes" means schools, places of instruction, churches, community halls, clinics, créches and similar uses.

The construction of a building and the sale of goods manufactured and produced on site or which are related to the main use may be permitted by the special consent of the Local Authority.
 - (b) The building value of the main building, including the outbuildings to be erected on the erf, shall be at least two times the valuation of the erf by the Local Authority.
 - (c) Notwithstanding items (a) and (b), a tannery or abattoir of any kind shall not be constructed on the erf without the written consent of the Minister of Regional, Local Government and Housing.

 - (a) There shall be no obstruction or deviation of any natural course of storm water over the erf without the written approval of the Local Authority.
 - (b) The erf is subject to the reservation for the Local Authority the right of access and use without compensation of the area three metres parallel with any boundary of such erf, for the construction and maintenance of municipal services in respect of water, sewerage, drainage, electricity and gas, which right includes the right to place on such erf temporarily any material that may be excavated during such operation on the erf or any adjacent erf.
 - (c) If the erf has more than one street frontage, access to the erf shall be obtained from the street determined by the Local Authority.

- (d) No offensive trade shall be established or conducted on the erf.
