2. PURPOSE OF SPECIAL LEVY

The special animal health levy shall be utilised for the provision of veterinary services in such a manner as the Meat Board of Namibia may determine from time to time with the approval of the Minister.

3. PAYMENT OF LEVIES

The general and special levies set out in paragraph 1 shall be paid by all producers slaughtering in, or exporting from, Namibia only livestock mentioned in that paragraph except natural persons or *bona fide* farmers who slaughter any such livestock for their own use.
