DECLARATION OF REGISTERED COLLECTIVE AGREEMENT RELATING TO EMPLOYERS AND EMPLOYEES EMPLOYED IN THE SECURITY INDUSTRY: LABOUR ACT, 1992

Under section 70(1) of the Labour Act, 1992 (Act No. 6 of 1992), and on the written request of the Security Association of Namibia, Namibia Transport and Allied Workers Union and Namibia Security Guards and Watchmen's Union, I -

- (a) give notice that the collective agreement published under Government Notice No. 132 of 15 October 2005 (agreement), and which came into force on 1 March 2005, is amended by the Memorandum of Agreement, set out in the Schedule, signed on 6 September 2007; and
- (b) declare that every employer and employee within the security industry who, on 6 September 2007, was not party to the agreement are bound by that agreement, as amended, as from the date of publication of this notice.

## **SCHEDULE**

## MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

The undersigned parties hereby agree to settle their dispute concerning minimum wages as follows:

- 1. The minimum wage for security personnel shall be increased from N\$2.09 per hour to N\$3.00 per hour.
- 2. This agreement will cover the period from 1 September 2007 until 28 February 2009.
- 3. Employers shall provide all employees with uniforms on the following basis:
  - 3.1 A newly-appointed employee shall be required to pay a deposit equivalent to the cost of the uniform;
  - 3.2 The employer shall refund the deposit to the employee at the time of the employee's termination of service upon return of the uniform;
  - 3.3 The employer shall replace the uniform of each employee, as needed, at the employer's expenses.
