REQUEST FOR SUBMISSION OF NAMES OF QUALIFIED PERSONS TO BE APPOINTED AS MEMBERS OF THE NAMIBIA MEDICINES REGULATORY COUNCIL: MEDICINES AND RELATED SUBSTANCES CONTROL ACT, 2003

In terms of subsection (2)(a) of section 3 of the Medicines and Related Substances Control Act, 2003 (Act No. 13 of 2003), the Minister responsible for health requests any interested body to submit, within thirty days from the date of publication of this notice, names of suitably qualified -

- (a) medical practitioners -
 - (i) one of whom is registered as a medical specialist;

DECLARATION OF OSHIFO TO BE AN APPROVED TOWNSHIP: TOWNSHIPS AND DIVISION OF LAND ORDINANCE, 1963

In terms of section 13 of the Townships and Division of Land Ordinance, 1963 (Ordinance No. 11 of 1963), I declare that the area situated on Portion 3 of Ruacana Town and Townlands No. 998 in the Registration Division "A" as indicated on General Plan No. 153 (S. G. No. 93/98) to be an approved township.

The conditions, subject to which the application for permission to establish the township concerned has been granted, are set forth in the Schedule below in terms of the said section 13.

SCHEDULE

1. Name of Township

The township shall be called Oshifo.

2. Composition of Township

The township comprises 291 erven numbered 1 to 291 and the remainder streets as indicated on General Plan A153 (S. G. No. 93/98).

3. Reservation of erven

- (1) The following erven are reserved for the State:
 - "(a) Erven 44, 66, 112 are reserved for educational purposes; and
 - (b) Erven 57, 191 are reserved for general administration purposes.".
- (2) Erven 1, 113, 152, 176, 190 and 192 are reserved for the Local Authority for the purposes of public open spaces.

4. Conditions of title

- (1) The following conditions shall be registered in favour of the Local Authority against the title deeds of all erven, except the erven referred to in paragraph 3:
 - "(a) There shall be no obstruction or deviation of any natural course of storm water over the erf without the written approval of the Local Authority;
 - (b) The erf shall be subject to the reservation by the Local Authority of the right of access and use without compensation of the area three meters parallel with any boundary of such erf for the construction and maintenance of local authority services in respect of water, sewerage, drainage, electricity and gas, which right includes the

- right to place on such erf temporarily any materials that may be excavated or used during such operations on the erf or any adjacent erven;
- (c) If the erf has more than one street frontage, access to the erf shall be obtained from the street determined by the Local Authority;
- (d) No offensive trade may be established or conducted on the erven:
 - For the purposes of this paragraph, "offensive trade" means any of the business, trade, work or institutions mentioned in regulation 1(a) of the Regulations promulgated under Government Notice No. 141 of 10 November 1926; and
- (e) No cattle, pigs, goats, sheep, monkeys, beast of prey or draught animals, shall be kept or allowed on the erf.".
- (2) The following conditions shall, in addition to those specified in subparagraph (1) above, be registered in favour of the Local Authority against the title deeds of Erven 2 to 43, 45 to 56, 58 to 65, 67 to 110, 177 to 189, 193 to 273, 275 to 291:
 - "(a) The erf shall be used for residential purposes only; and
 - (b) The building value of a main building, including the outbuildings to be erected on the erf, shall be at least two times the prevailing valuation of the erf by the Local Authority.".
- (3) The following conditions shall, in addition to those specified in subparagraph (1), be registered against the title deeds of erven 115 to 151, 153 to 175:
 - "(a) The erf shall only be used for flats and business purposes other than as a factory as defined in regulation 14 of the Health and Safety of Employees at Work regulations promulgated under Government Notice No. 156 of 1 August 1997: Provided that where a building is erected for business purposes the ground floor of the main building shall not contain flats and no flats shall be constructed on the same floor as any business or offices; and
 - (b) The building value of the main building, including the outbuildings, to be erected on the erf shall be at least two times the prevailing valuation of the erf by the Local Authority.".
- (4) The following conditions shall, in addition to those specified in subparagraph (1), be registered in favour of the Local Authority against the title deeds of Erven 111, 114 and 247:
 - "(a) The erf shall only be used for institutional purposes and purposes incidental thereto; and
 - (b) The building value of the main building, excluding the outbuildings, to be erected on the erf shall be at least three times the prevailing valuation of the erf by the Local Authority.".

G. A 371/98) to be an approved township.

The conditions, subject to which the application for permission to establish the township concerned has been granted, are set out in the Schedule below in terms of the said section 13.

- (1) Erf 310 is reserved for the State for educational purposes.
- (2) Erven 587 to 588 are reserved for the Local Authority for the purpose of public open space.

4. Conditions of title

- (1) The following conditions shall be registered in favour of the Local Authority against the title deeds of all erven except the erven referred to in paragraph 3:
 - "(a) There shall be no obstruction or deviation of any natural course of storm water over the erf without the written approval of the Local Authority.

d) No offensive trade whatsoever shall be established or conducted on the erf.

For the purpose of this paragraph, "offensive trade" means any of the businesses, trades, works or institutions mentioned in regulation 1(a) of the regulations promulgated under Government Notice 141 of 1926; and

- e) No cattle, pigs, goats, sheep, monkeys, beast of prey or draught animals, shall be kept or allowed on the erf.".
- (2) The following conditions shall, in addition to those enumerated in subparagraph (1), be registered against the title deeds of 292 to 309, 311 to 507, 509 to 586:
 - "(a) The erf shall be used for residential purposes only; and
 - b) The building value of a dwelling unit, including the outbuildings to be erected on the erf, shall be at least two times the prevailing valuation of the erf by the Local Authority.".
- (3) The following conditions shall, in addition to those enumerated in subparagraph (1), be registered against the title deeds of erf 508:
 - "(a) The erf shall only be used for institutional purposes and purposes incidental thereto.
 - b) The building value of the main building, including the outbuildings, to be erected on the erf shall be at least three times the prevailing valuation of the erf by the Local Authority.
