MERCHANDISE MARKS ACT, 1941: PROPOSED PROHIBITION OF THE USE OF A CERTAIN TRADE MARK

In terms of section 13 of the Merchandise Marks Act, 1941 (Act No. 17 of 1941), I give notice that the Namibian Competition Commission has requested me to prohibit, under section 15(1) of that Act, the use by any person other than that Commission of the mark below in connection with any trade, business, profession or occupation or in connection with a trade mark, mark or trade description applied to goods.
