In terms of section 13 of the Townships and Division of Land Ordinance, 1963 (Ordinance 11 of 1963), I

- (a) declare the area situated on Portion 114 of the Swakopmund Town and Townlands No. 41, Registration Division "G", as indicated on the General Plan No. G 177 to be an approved township; and
- (b) set forth in the Schedule the conditions subject to which the application for permission to establish the township concerned has been granted.

### **SCHEDULE**

### 1. Name of township:

The township must be called Swakopmund Extention 23.

# 2. Composition of township:

The township comprises 122 erven numbered 5858 to 5979 and the remainder streets as indicated on General Plan G 177.

### 3. Reservation of erven:

The following erven are reserved for the local authority:

- (a) for the purpose of an electric substation, erf 5978;
- (b) for the purpose of public open spaces, erf 5979.

### 4. Conditions of title:

- 1. The following conditions shall be registered in favour of the local authority against the title deeds of all erven, except the erven referred to in paragraphs 3, 4(2) and 4(3):
  - (a) The erf may only be used or occupied for purposes which are in accordance with the provisions of the Swakopmund Town Planning Scheme prepared and approved in terms of the Town Planning Ordinance, 1954 (Ordinance 18 of 1954).
  - (b) The value of the main building, including the outbuildings, to be erected on the erf must be at least four times the local authority evaluation of the erf.
- 2. The following conditions must be registered in favour of the Local Authority against the title deeds of Erven 5891 and 5894:
  - (a) The erf may only be used or occupied for purposes which are in accordance with the provisions of the Swakopmund Town Planning Scheme prepared and approved in terms of the Town Planning Ordinance, 1954 (Ordinance 18 of 1954).
  - (b) The value of the main building, including the outbuildings, to be erected on the erf must be at least two times the local authority evaluation of the erf.
- 3. The following conditions must be registered in favour of the Local Authority against the title deed of Erf 5977:
  - (a) The erf may only be used or occupied for purposes which are in accordance with the provisions of the Swakopmund Town Planning Scheme prepared and approved in terms of the Town Planning Ordinance, 1954 (Ordinance 18 of 1954).
  - (b) The value of the main building, including the outbuildings, to be erected on the erf must be at least equal to the local authority evaluation of the erf.
