AMENDMENT OF GOVERNMENT NOTICE NO. 89 OF 1 JUNE 2015: DETERMINATION OF FORMULA FOR FUNDING OF POLITICAL PARTIES, PERCENTAGE OF UNSPENT MONIES THAT MAY BE RETAINED BY POLITICAL PARTIES AND ANCILLARY MATTERS: ELECTORAL ACT, 2014

Under section 13 of the Interpretation of Laws Proclamation, 1920 (Proclamation No. 37 of 1920), I give notice that in terms of Part 3 of Chapter 4 of the Electoral Act, 2014 (Act No. 5 of 2014) I have, with the approval of the National Assembly, amended Government Notice No. 89 of 1 June 2015 by the substitution for paragraph 5 of the Schedule to that notice of the following paragraph -

“5. (1) The Secretary of the National Assembly must, in accordance with section 156(1) of the Act, cause to be paid the allocations to which a political party is entitled as determined in terms of paragraphs 2 and 3 to the political party in question in four equal instalments, each within three months of the previous payment.

(2) The four instalments to each political party referred to subparagraph (1) will be paid quarterly in equal instalments on the first working day in April, July, October and January of each financial year in question.

(3) Despite subparagraphs (1) and (2), in the year that the National Assembly and Presidential Elections are to be held, the final instalment may be paid any day prior to the day on which the elections will be held.”.
