A LAW TO AMEND THE HIGH COURT LAW CAP. H5, LAW'S OF LAGOS STATE 2015 AND FOR CONNECTED PURPOSES.

Commencement (22nd February: 2019)

THE LAGOS STATE HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY enacts as follows:

 The High Court Law Cap. H5, Laws of Lagos State, 2015 (referred to in this Law as the "Principal Law") is amended as follows - Amendment to the Principal Law

 The Principal Law is amended by deleting Section 2 and replacing it as follows - Amendment to Section 2.

- The number of Judges of the High Court, shall in addition to the Chief Judge be one hundred and twenty (120).
- (2) The one hundred and twenty (120) Judges shall be appointed in the manner prescribed under Section 271 of the 1999 Constitution (as amended).
- (3) The Court shall be deemed to be duly constituted notwithstanding any vacancy in the office of Chief Judge or of any Judge.
- This Law may be cited as the High Court (Amendment) Law and shall come into force on the 22nd day of February 2019.
