**A LAW TO AMEND THE HIGH COURT LAW CAP. H5, LAWS OF LAGOS
STATE 2015 AND FOR CONNECTED PURPOSES.**

Commencement (22nd February 2019)

THE LAGOS STATE HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY enacts as follows:

1. The High Court Law Cap. H5, Laws of Lagos State, 2015 (referred to in this Law as the "Principal Law") is amended as follows -

Amendment to
the Principal Law
2. The Principal Law is amended by deleting Section 2 and replacing it as follows -

Amendment
to Section 2.

 - (1) The number of Judges of the High Court, shall in addition to the Chief Judge be one hundred and twenty (120).
 - (2) The one hundred and twenty (120) Judges shall be appointed in the manner prescribed under Section 271 of the 1999 Constitution (as amended).
 - (3) The Court shall be deemed to be duly constituted notwithstanding any vacancy in the office of Chief Judge or of any Judge.
3. This Law may be cited as the High Court (Amendment) Law and shall come into force on the 22nd day of February 2019.
