EDUCATION (LAGOS) ORDINANCE, 1957
(No. 26 of 1957)Education (Lagos) (Relaxation of Building Bye-Laws) (No. 3)
Order, 1958

Commencement : 19th June, 1958

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 27 of the Education (Lagos) Ordinance, 1957, the Minister of Education has made the following order—

1. This Order may be cited as the Education (Lagos) (Relaxation of Building Bye-laws) (No. 3) Order, 1958.

2. The provisions of the Townships (Lagos) Bye-laws set out in the second column of the Schedule hereto, and the provisions of the Lagos Building Regulations, 1957, set out in the third column of the said Schedule shall not apply in relation to the buildings set out in the first column of the said Schedule, plans of which have been approved in accordance with section 27 of the Education (Lagos) Ordinance, 1957.

INCOME TAX ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 92)

Railway Loan (International Bank) (Exemption of Interest) Notice, 1958

Commencement : 19th June, 1958

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 9 (2) of the Income Tax Ordinance, the Governor-General on the advice of the Council of Ministers, hereby directs that in respect of the loan raised by the Government of the Federation from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development under the authority of the Railway Loan (International Bank) Ordinance, 1958 (No. 10 of 1958), and in respect of any Bonds issued by the Government of the Federation to secure the repayment of the said loan or any part thereof, any interest payable on such loan or on such bonds shall be exempted from the tax payable under the said Income Tax Ordinance, except where the interest in a Bond is payable to a holder thereof, other than the Bank, and such Bond is beneficially owned by an individual or a corporate resident of Nigeria.
