

(UNDER THE NIGERIA (ELECTORAL PROVISIONS) ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1958)

Establishment of Electoral Districts Proclamation, 1958

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor-General by section 4 of the Nigeria (Electoral Provisions) Order in Council, 1958, I, RALPH FRANCIS ALNWICK GREY, Knight Commander of the Royal Victorian Order; Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Officer Administering the Government of the Federation, do hereby proclaim that Nigeria shall be divided into the three hundred and twenty areas specified in the Schedule to this Proclamation, and that each such area shall be an electoral district under the constituency name specified in such Schedule, for the purpose of returning one member to the proposed House of Representatives referred to in the Order in Council under the authority of which this Proclamation is made.

GIVEN under my hand and the Public Seal of the Federation the 14th day of July, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-eight.
