Exclusive Legislative List (Declaration of Federal Ports) Order, 1959

In exercise of the powers conferred by Item 22 of Part I of the First Schedule to the Nigeria (Constitution) Order in Council, 1954, the Governor-General, after consultation with the Council of Ministers, has made the following Order—

1. This Order may be cited as the Exclusive Legislative List (Declaration of Federal Ports) Order, 1959, and shall be of Federal application.
2. The following port is declared to be a Federal Port for the purpose of the Nigeria (Constitution) Orders in Council, 1954 to 1958.

Antiquities (Monuments) Declaration (No. 4) Notice, 1959

Commencement : 12th June, 1959

WHEREAS the Antiquities Commission has submitted an application in accordance with subsection (4) of section 14 of the Antiquities Ordinance, 1953 (hereinafter referred to as the Ordinance) for the declaration as monuments of the antiquities as set forth in the Schedule to this notice :

AND WHEREAS the application has been considered by the Governor-General in Council :

NOW THEREFORE in exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (5) of section 14 of the Ordinance the Governor-General, after consultation with the Council of Ministers, hereby gives the following notice—

1. This notice may be cited as the Antiquities (Monuments) Declaration (No. 4) Notice, 1959.
2. The antiquities set forth in the Schedule to this notice are declared to be monuments.
