LOCAL LOANS (REGISTERED STOCK AND SECURITIES) (ORDINANCE) (CHAPTER 120)

Local Loan (Federation of Nigeria Development Loan, 1979)

Directions (No. 2), 1959

Commencement: 6th August, 1959

WHEREAS by the Loan (Internal Borrowing) Ordinance, 1958, the Governor-General is authorised to raise a loan or loans in Nigeria not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of Twenty Million Pounds:

AND WHEREAS it is also provided in the said Ordinance that such loan or loans shall be raised in any manner provided by the Local Loans (Registered Stock and Securities) Ordinance:

AND WHEREAS by the Local Loan (Federation of Nigeria Development Loan, 1979) Directions, 1959, it was specified that a loan of one million pounds shall be raised on the terms therein specified:

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to increase the amount of the loan by three hundred and fifty-five thousand, three hundred and sixty pounds:

NOW THEREFORE in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Minister by section 5 of the Local Loans (Registered Stock and Securities) Ordinance the following directions are given—

1. These directions may be cited as the Local Loan (Federation of Nigeria Development Loan, 1979) (No. 2) Directions, 1959, and shall be of Federal application.

Citation and application.

2. The loan raised under the Local Loan (Federation of Nigeria Development Loan, 1979) Directions, 1959, (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Directions) shall be increased to one million, three hundred and fifty-five thousand, three hundred and sixty pounds.

Increase of amount of loan.

3. The provisions of the Principal Directions shall apply to the additional amount raised under these directions as they apply to the amount of one million pounds raised under the Principal Directions.

Declaration of Pensionable Offices (Lagos Town Council)

Notice, 1959

Commencement : 6th August, 1959

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Lagos Town Council by section 83 (2) of the Lagos Local Government Law, 1953, the following declaration has been made with the approval of the Minister of Lagos Affairs, Mines and Power.

Citation and application.

1. This Order may be cited as the Declaration of Pensionable Offices (Lagos Town Council) Notice, 1959, and shall have application in the Federal Territory of Lagos.

Declaration of pensionable offices.

2. The offices mentioned in the schedule hereto are hereby declared pensionable offices within the meaning of section 83 (2) of the Lagos Local Government Law, 1953, with effect from the dates specified therein.
