# THE MINERALS ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 134)

### The Prospecting (Areas and Minerals) Prohibition Declaration, 1960

Commencement: 3rd March, 1960.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 8 of the Minerals Ordinance, the Minister of Mines and Power has made the following declaration:

1. This declaration may be cited as the Prospecting (Areas and Minerals) Prohibition Declaration, 1960.

Citation.

2. Immediately after paragraph 20 of the Prospecting (Areas and Minerals) Prohibition Declaration, 1946, there shall be inserted the following new paragraphs:—

Amendment of Public Notice 22 of 1946 (Vol. VIII, p. 562).

"21. The following area is hereby declared to be closed to prospecting for all minerals:—

All that parcel of land known as Mines Reclamation Area No. 24 of Jos Division of Plateau Province, containing an area of approximately 225.6 acres, the boundaries of which are described below:—

Starting at a concrete pillar marked PB P7171 the Colony Coordinates of which are 2,082,667 feet North and 2,323,018 feet East and which lies on a bearing of 329° 08' at a distance of 3,276 feet from Trig Point YK451, the boundaries run in straight lines, the bearings and lengths of which are as follows:—

### THE MINERALS ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 134)

The Prospecting (Areas and Minerals) Prohibition (Amendment) Declaration, 1960

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 8 of the Minerals Ordinance upon the Minister to whom responsibility for minerals is assigned, the following Declaration is hereby made:

## Commencement: 3rd March, 1960

- 1. This Declaration may be cited as the Prospecting (Areas and Minerals) Prohibition (Amendment) Declaration, 1960.
- 2. Paragraph 5 of the Prospecting (Areas and Minerals) Prohibition Declaration, 1946 (as amended by the Prospecting (Areas and Minerals) Prohibition (Amendment) Declaration, 1951) is hereby revoked.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This amendment declaration is desirable in order to revoke paragraph 5 of the Prospecting (Areas and Minerals) Prohibition Declaration, 1946 (as amended in 1951) by which the Kassa basalt is closed to general prospecting. Thus the new amendment declaration will throw open to general prospecting the Kassa basalt like other areas on the Jos Plateau.
