The following Bill, which will in due course be presented to the House of Representatives for enactment, is published for general information.

An Ordinance to amend the Audit Ordinance, 1956.

Title.

[1st September, 1959]

Commence-

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislature of the Federation of Nigeria as follows—

Enactment.

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Audit (Amendment) Ordinance, 1960, and shall be of Federal application.

(2) This Ordinance shall be deemed to have had effect from the 1st September, 1959.

Short title, application and commencement.

2. Section 3 of the Audit Ordinance, 1956, is amended by the deletion from subsection (1) of the words "Two Thousand Six Hundred and Forty Pounds" and the substitution therefor of the following—
"Two Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty Pounds".

Amendment of section 3. No. 38 of 1956.

Objects and Reasons

This Bill seeks to amend the Audit Ordinance, 1956, to reflect the recent increase in salaries of members of the Federal Public Service as affecting the Director of Federal Audit.
