CUSTOMS TARIFF ORDINANCE, 1958 (No. 60 of 1958)

Customs Tariff (Duties and Exemptions) (No. 4) Order, 1960

Commencement: 30th June, 1960

In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (1) of section 6 of the Customs Tariff Ordinance, 1958, the Governor-General, after consultation with the Council of Ministers, has made the following Order—

- This Order may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Duties and Exemptions)
 (No. 4) Order, 1960, and shall be of Federal application.
- 2. The Second Schedule to the Customs Tariff Ordinance, 1958 (which relates to exemptions from import duties of customs) as the same was replaced by the Customs Tariff (Duties and Exemptions) Order, 1959, is amended by the addition after item 71 of the following new item—
 - "72. Goods imported by Catholic Relief Services where the Minister of Finance is satisfied that—
 - (a) adequate arrangements have been made for their distribution free of charge within Nigeria to the poor and needy;
 - (b) they are imported for the official use of the Programme Director for Nigeria of Catholic Relief Services."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order exempts from import duty goods imported by Catholic Relief Services for distribution free of charge within Nigeria to the poor and needy, and goods imported for the official use of the Programme Director for Nigeria of Catholic Relief Services. This exemption does not extend to the personal effects of any of the Catholic Relief Services staff.
