INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT (INCOME TAX RELIEF)  
ORDINANCE, 1958 (No. 8 OF 1958)Industrial Development (Income Tax Relief)  
(Other Metal Goods) Order, 1960*Commencement : 28th July, 1960*

In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (4) of section 3 of the Industrial Development (Income Tax Relief) Ordinance, 1956, the Governor-General, after consultation with the Council of Ministers, has made the following order—

1. This Order may be cited as the Industrial Development (Income Tax Relief) (Other Metal Goods) Order, 1960, and shall be of Federal application.

Citation and application.

2. The Schedule to the Aid to Pioneer Industries (No. 1) Order, 1958, is amended by the addition, under the head "Products", of the following:—

"and other goods made wholly or partly of metal other than precious metal".

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

The effect of this amendment is to extend the scope of the existing Pioneer Industries Order to include any other goods manufactured wholly or partly of metal other than precious metal. Nigerian College of Arts, Science and Technology (Pensionable  
Appointments) Notice, 1960*Commencement : 28th July, 1960*

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 15 of the Nigerian College of Arts, Science and Technology Ordinance, 1952, the Governor-General, on the recommendation of the Council of the Nigerian College of Arts, Science and Technology and after consultation with the Council of Ministers, has varied the Second Schedule to that Ordinance as follows—
