## MINERALS ORDINANCE (CAP. 121)

Prospecting (Areas and Minerals) Prohibition Declaration, 1961

Commencement: 24th May, 1961

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 8 of the Minerals Ordinance, the Minister of Mines and Power of the Federation has made the following declaration-

Citation.

- 1. This declaration may be cited as the Prospecting (Areas and Minerals) Prohibition Amendment (No. 2) Declaration, 1961.
- 2. Immediately after paragraph 29 of the Prospecting (Areas and Minerals) Prohibition Declaration, 1946, there shall be inserted the following new paragraph:---
  - "30. The following area is hereby declared to be closed to prospecting for all minerals :-

All that parcel of land known as Shen-Zawan-Du Village Area situated in Jos Division of Plateau Province, consisting of approximately 11,340.00 acres, the boundary of which is delineated by a red verge line on plan MISC.113, and is more particularly described as follows:-

Starting at Survey Trig. Point YK2477 the Colony co-ordinates of which are 2,080,659 feet North, and 2,355,884 feet East, the boundary runs from :-

YK2477 on a bearing of 265°41' for a distance of 2,665.4 feet to Z5 and Z5 on a bearing of 265°30' for a distance of 9,746.0 feet to YK2478 YK2478 on a bearing of 276°16' for a distance of 11,926.0 feet to Z6 Z6 on a bearing of 241°03' for a distance of 2,270.7 feet to Z7
