### EXCISE TARIFF ORDINANCE, 1958 (No. 58 of 1958)

## Excise Duties (Amendment) Order, 1961

Commencement: 15th June, 1961

In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (1) of section 3 of the Excise Tariff Ordinance, 1958, the Governor-General, acting in accordance with the advice of the Council of Ministers, has made the following Order—

- 1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Excise Duties (Amendment) Order, 1961, and shall come into operation on the 15th June, 1961.
  - (2) This Order shall apply throughout the Federation.
- 2. The Schedule to the Excise Tariff Ordinance, 1958, as the same was replaced by the Excise Duties (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1959, is amended by the deletion in item 3 of the figures "0 1 4" and the substitution therefor of the figures "0 0 8".

This Order reduces the excise duty on mineral waters and other nonalcoholic aerated beverages manufactured in Nigeria from 1s-4d per gallon to 8d per gallon.

## PORTS ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 155)

### Nigerian Ports Authority Docks and Premises (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1961

Commencement: 15th June, 1961
