The following Bill, which will in due course be presented to Parliament for enactment, is published for general information.

The sums set forth in the Schedule hereto are hereby declared 25 to have been duly and necessarily applied and expended for the services therein set forth and are hereby approved, allowed and granted in addition to the sums provided for such services by the Appropriation Ordinance, the Supplementary Appropriation Ordinance, and the Supplementary Appropriation Act. 30
