The Customs Tariff (Duties and Exemptions)

(No. 7) Order, 1962

Commencement : 18th October, 1962

In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (1) of section 6 of the Customs Tariff Act, 1958, the Governor-General, acting in accordance with the advice of the Council of Ministers, has made the following Order—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Duties and Exemptions) (No. 7) Order, 1962, and shall apply throughout the Federation.

Citation
and extent.

2. The Second Schedule to the Customs Tariff Act, 1958 (which relates to exemptions from import duties of Customs) as the same was replaced by the Customs Tariff (Duties and Exemptions) Order, 1959 is amended by the addition after item 18 of the following new item—

MONEYLENDERS ACT (CHAPTER 136)

The Commonwealth Development Finance Company Limited
(Exemption) Order, 1962*Commencement : 28th September, 1962*

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 2A of the Moneylenders (Amendment) Act, 1960, the Minister of Internal Affairs had made the following order—

1. This Order may be cited as the Commonwealth Development Finance Company Limited (Exemption) Order, 1962, and shall apply in respect of all the regions in the Federation of Nigeria.

Citation and
application.

2. The Commonwealth Development Finance Company Limited, a limited company incorporated under the provisions of the Companies Ordinance, whose registered office is at 5 Customs Street, Lagos, shall be exempt from the provisions of section 12A (3) of the Moneylenders (Amendment) Act, 1960.
