Minerals Delegation of Powers (Eastern Nigeria) Notice, 1962

Commencement: 15th November, 1962

Whereas the Governor of Eastern Nigeria, acting in accordance with the advice of the Executive Council, has resolved pursuant to subsection (1) of section 121 of the Minerals Act that the exercise within that Region under that Act of the powers specified in the Schedule and hereinafter delegated to the Minister of Town Planning of Eastern Nigeria shall be exercised in accordance with any general conditions of policy that may be stipulated by the Federal Minister of Mines and Power:

Now THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 121 of the Minerals Act and section 5 of the Ministers Statutory Powers and Duties (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, the Federal Minister of Mines and Power gives the following notice—

1. This notice may be cited as the Minerals Delegation of Powers (Eastern Nigeria) Notice, 1962.

Citation.

Delegation of powers.

- 2. The Federal Minister of Mines and Power hereby delegates to the Minister of Town Planning of Eastern Nigeria the exercise within that Region of the powers specified in the first column of the Schedule conferred upon him by the sections of the Minerals Act specified in the second column opposite thereto.
- 3. The delegation of powers hereby made revokes the previous delegation of those powers made to the Governor of Eastern Nigeria under the Interpretation Act, and item 24 of Public Notice 47 of 1940 (as amended from time to time) shall be further amended accordingly.
