## Small Craft (Amendment) Regulations, 1963

Commencement: 1st August, 1963

In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (1) of Section 69 of the Customs and Excise Management Act, 1958, the Governor-General has made the following regulations:-

1. These regulations may be cited as the Small Craft (Amendment) Regulations, 1963, and shall apply throughout the Federation.

2. The Small Craft Regulations, 1959 are amended by the deletion of

paragraph (b) of regulation 2 and the substitution therefor of the following— "Limits outside which certain small crafts

may not be

used.

(b) Eastward of West Point Beacon, Calabar River outside the area bounded by the coasts of Nigeria and a line drawn from West Point Beacon, Calabar River, to a point on a bearing 180 degrees ten nautical miles from East Point, Calabar River."

Alteration of limits outside which certain small crafts are not permitted.
