IMMIGRATION ACT, 1963

The Joseph Sadisa Deportation Order, 1963

WHEREAS on the 4th day of July, 1963 before the Magistrate's Court, Lagos, JOSEPH SADISA, was charged with offences contrary to subsection (1) and paragraph (a) of subsection (2), of section 12 of the Immigration Act (Chapter 84) (now repealed) :

AND WHEREAS the said Court in exercise of the power conferred by subsection (1) of section 16 of the said Act has, without proceeding to conviction, recommended that the said Joseph Sadisa be deported from Nigeria :

AND WHEREAS I, ALHAJI SHEHU SHAGARI, Federal Minister of Internal Affairs after considering the recommendation aforesaid, have thought it fit to make a deportation Order :

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by subsection (1) of section 20 of the Immigration Act (No. 6 of 1963), it is hereby ordered that the said JOSEPH SADISA shall leave on the first available opportunity and remain thereafter out of Nigeria.

The Alphonse Basome Deportation Order, 1963

WHEREAS on the 4th day of July, 1963 before the Magistrate's Court, Lagos, ALPHONSE BASOME, was charged with offences contrary to subsection (1) and paragraph (a) of subsection (2), of section 12 of the Immigration Act (Chapter 84) (now repealed) :

AND WHEREAS the said Court in exercise of the power conferred by subsection (1) of section 16 of the said Act has, without proceeding to conviction, recommended that the said ALPHONSE BASOME be deported from Nigeria :

AND WHEREAS I, ALHAJI SHEHU SHAGARI, Federal Minister of Internal Affairs after considering the recommendation aforesaid, have thought it fit to make a deportation Order :

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by subsection (1) of section 20 of the Immigration Act (No. 6 of 1963), it is hereby ordered that the said ALPHONSE BASOME shall leave on the first available opportunity and remain thereafter out of Nigeria.
