The Fritz Iteles—Deportation Order, 1963

Commencement: 3rd September, 1963

Whereas on the 10th day of May, 1963, one Fritz Iteles was convicted without the option of a fine, of offences under the Criminal Code Act, at the Magistrates' Court, Uyo, Eastern Region of Nigeria:

AND WHEREAS the said Court, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 404 of the Criminal Procedure Act, has recommended to me that the said Fritz Iteles be deported from Nigeria:

AND WHEREAS after considering the recommendation I am satisfied that it is in the interest of peace, order and good government that an Order of deportation should be made:

Now, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 410 of the Criminal Procedure Act, I, Shehu Shagari, being the Minister charged with the responsibility for deportation, hereby order that the said Fritz Iteles shall leave Nigeria on the first available opportunity and thereafter remain out of Nigeria.

Merchant Shipping Act (Delegation of Powers) Notice, 1963

Commencement: 12th September, 1963
