FIREARMS ACT (CHAPTER 69)

Firearms Prohibition (Eastern Nigeria) Order, 1964

Commencement: 9th July, 1964

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 36 of the Firearms Act and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following Order—

1. This Order may be cited as the Firearms Prohibition (Eastern Nigeria) Order, 1964 and shall apply to Eastern Nigeria.

Citation and application.

2. The possession of or dealing in any firearms or ammunition in the Okrika Local Council area in Eastern Nigeria, is hereby absolutely prohibited for a period of six months from the date of publication of this Order in the Federation of Nigeria Official Gazette.

Prohibition.

3. All firearms and ammunition in possession of any person within the area specified in the foregoing section 2 of this Order shall be surrendered to the Assistant Commissioner of Police, Port Harcourt within seven days from the date of the publication of this Order.

Surrender.
