Exercise of Functions by Superior Police Officers (Consent) Notice, 1964

In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (2) of section one hundred of the Constitution of the Federation, the President has given his consent to the exercise by superior police officers of the functions conferred upon them by the Casino (Licensing and Taxation) Law, 1964 of Western Nigeria.
