

The following Bill, which will in due course be presented to Parliament for enactment, is published for general information.

SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION (1964-65) BILL

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill makes further supplementary provision for the service of the Federation for the financial year 1964-65.

A BILL

FOR

AN ACT TO AUTHORISE THE ISSUE OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED REVENUE FUND OF THE SUM NINE HUNDRED AND FORTY-TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED AND SEVENTY POUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING FURTHER PROVISION FOR THE SERVICE OF THE YEAR ENDING ON THE THIRTY-FIRST DAY OF MARCH, ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FIVE; AND TO APPROPRIATE THAT AMOUNT FOR THE PURPOSES SPECIFIED IN THAT ACT.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislature of the Federation of Nigeria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

Commence-
ment.

1. The aggregate amount mentioned in section one of the Appropriation Act, 1964 and section one of the Supplementary Appropriation (1964-65) Act, 1964 (which together provide for the issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund in respect of the year ending on 31st March, 1965 of sums not exceeding in aggregate to £63,123,480) shall be increased by nine hundred and forty-two thousand five hundred and seventy pounds and the additional amount shall be appropriated to heads of expenditure as indicated in the Schedule to this Act; and subsection (3) of section one of the Appropriation Act, 1964 (which provides for the lapse of balances outstanding at the end of the financial year) shall have effect accordingly.
