This Bill makes final supplementary provision for the service of the Federation for the financial year 1963-64.

A BILL

FOR

AN ACT TO AUTHORISE THE ISSUE OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED REVENUE FUND OF FOUR HUNDRED AND THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE POUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING FURTHER PROVISION FOR THE SERVICE OF THE YEAR WHICH ENDED ON THE THIRTY-FIRST DAY OF MARCH. ONE THOUSAND, NINE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FOUR; AND TO APPROPRIATE THAT SUM FOR THE PURPOSES SPECIFIED IN THIS ACT.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislature of the Federation of Nigeria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :---

1. The total of the amounts mentioned in section one of the *Appropriation Act, 1963, section one of Supplementary Appropriation (1963-64) Act, 1963, section one of the Supplementary Appropriation (1963-64) Act, 1964 and Supplementary Appropriation (1963-64) (No. 2) Act, 1964 (which together provide for the issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund in respect of the year which ended on 31st March 1964 10 of the sum not exceeding in aggregate $f_{.59,054,160}$ shall be increased by four hundred and thirty-five thousand, nine hundred and twenty-three pounds; and the additional amount shall be appropriated to heads of expenditure as indicated in the Schedule to this Act; and subsection (3) of section one of the Appropriation Act, 1964 (which provides for the

lapse of balances outstanding at the end of the financial year) shall 15 have effect accordingly.

2. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (1963-64) Act, 1965 and shall apply throughout the Federation.
