IMMIGRATION ACT, 1963 (1963, No. 6)

M. Sabo Abdou Alias Muhaman Sabo Alias Sabo Riga: Prohibited Immigrants Order 1965

Whereas as provided under subsection (3) of section 18 of the Immigration Act, 1963, I am of the opinion that Sabo Abdou alias Muhaman Sabo alias Sabo Riga should be classed as a prohibited immigrant:

Now therefore in exercise of the powers conferred on me by the said subsection (3) of section 18 of the Immigration Act, 1963, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby order that the said Sabo Abdou alias Muhaman Sabo alias Sabo Riga be classed as a prohibited immigrant and deported from Nigeria and shall leave on the next available opportunity and remain thereafter out of Nigeria.

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE FEDERATION (1963, No. 20)

Adaptation of Laws (Produce Inspection Board) Order, 1965

Commencement: 27th May, 1965

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 156 of the Constitution of the Federation, the President has made the following Order—

1. This Order may be cited as the Adaptation of Laws (Produce Inspection Board) Order, 1965 and shall apply to the same extent as the Produce (Enforcement of Export Standards) Act, 1959 applies within Nigeria.

Citation and extent.

- 2. Section 4 (2) of the Produce (Enforcement of Export Standards) Act, 1959 is hereby modified-
 - (a) by substituting the word "ten" for the word "nine" where it occurs;
 - (b) in paragraph (a) thereof-
 - (i) by substituting the word "eight" for the word "six" where it occurs; and
 - (ii) by inserting immediately after the word "Western" the word "Mid-Western"; and

Modification of section 4 (2) of Act 21 of 1959.

(c) by substituting in paragraph (b) thereof for the words from the beginning of the paragraph up to and including the word "persons" the words "one member from the Federal territory (not being a public officer)".

This Order enables Mid-Western Nigeria to be represented by two members on the Federal Produce Inspection Board and for membership of Southern Cameroons thereon to be abolished by reason that Southern Cameroons is no longer a part of the Federation.
